The Prophet Micah – which means “who is like the Lord?”

Key facts about Micah:

- **Origin:** Micah was an 8th-century BC prophet from Moresheth, a small rural town in the southern kingdom of Judah, who prophesied during the reigns of the Judahite kings Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah. This shaped his heart for the common people and gave him a sharp view of the injustice happening in powerful cities.

Name: The name Micah comes from the Hebrew *Mikayahu*, meaning "Who is like Yahweh?" The final verse of his book echoes this very question. (Micah 7: 18, "Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression").

- **Time period:** He was a contemporary of the prophet Isaiah and prophesied around the same time as the fall of the Northern Kingdom of Israel in 722 BC.

- **Prophecies:** His prophecies addressed the corruption, injustice and idolatry he saw in both Israel and Judah.

- **Key message:** His most famous passage, Micah 6: 8, calls for a life of justice, mercy and humility over mere ritual.

- **Messianic prophecies:** He is known for prophesying that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5: 2).

- **Hope for the future:** Alongside his warnings, he also delivered a message of hope, including a vision of a peaceful kingdom where nations would no longer go to war (Micah 4: 3 - 4).

- **Influence:** His prophecies were quoted by other prophets, such as Jeremiah, and are still significant today.

Micah boldly condemned the wealthy and powerful who took advantage of the poor. He had a strong message about caring for others and living with integrity. (Micah 2: 1 - 2, "Woe to those who plan iniquity. They covet fields and seize them").

Micah challenged the idea that God only wanted offerings and rituals. Instead, he spoke about what really pleases God: justice, mercy and humility.
