The Prophet Joel – which means “Yawheh is God”

Joel identifies himself as the son of Pethuel, a name mentioned nowhere else in the Old Testament (Joel 1: 1).

While some scholars believe he ministered to the returning exiles, the book's content suggests he may have prophesied around 835 BC, during the reign of King Joash, though this is still debated.

The prophet Joel was a biblical figure who delivered a message of repentance and judgment to the kingdom of Judah, using a devastating locust plague as a symbol of God's impending wrath. He urged the people to return to God with all their hearts, promising that if they did, God would show mercy and pour out his Spirit on all people. Joel is known as the author of the Book of Joel and is considered one of the Minor Prophets in the Old Testament.

- **Message of repentance:** The central theme of Joel's prophecy is the call to repentance in the face of a catastrophic "Day of the Lord". He describes a devastating locust plague as a foretaste of judgment for the people's sin, urging them to repent through fasting, weeping and mourning.
- **Promise of God's mercy:** Joel promises that God is "gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness". If the people repent, God will relent and restore their land.
- **The outpouring of the Spirit:** The book includes a significant prophecy about the future outpouring of God's Spirit on all people (Joel 2: 28 - 29), a passage quoted in the New Testament book of Acts (Acts 2: 17 - 18).
- **Judgment and salvation:** Ultimately, Joel's message is one of both judgment for evil and salvation for those who turn to God. He teaches that all nations will be held accountable before the Lord.
