A SHORT SUMMARY OF JUDAS ISCARIOT, THE APOSTLE

Judas Iscariot is the apostle who betrayed Jesus with a kiss. For this supreme act of treachery, some would say Judas made the greatest error in history.

Down through time, people have had mixed feelings about Judas. Some experience a sense of hatred toward him, others feel pity, and some have even considered him a hero. No matter how you react to Judas, one thing is certain, believers can benefit greatly by taking a serious look at his life.

The act of betrayal:

Judas identified Jesus to the arresting soldiers of the High Priest Caiaphas with a kiss, known as the "kiss of Judas". He then turned Jesus over to the soldiers, who subsequently handed him over to Pontius Pilate. After Jesus's condemnation, Matthew's Gospel (Matthew 27: 3-5) states that Judas felt remorse, returned the money, and hanged himself. The Book of Acts (Acts 1: 18) offers a different account, saying he bought a field and fell headlong, causing his insides to gush out.

Possible motives for Judas's betrayal are:

Greed: The Book of Matthew states Judas betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver, a bribe paid by the high priest. This indicates that a love for money was a primary motivator.

Disillusionment: Judas may have been disappointed that Jesus wasn't the powerful, military leader who would overthrow the Roman oppressors, as many Jews expected the Messiah to be. When Jesus's actions didn't match this expectation, Judas became angry and may have sought to provoke Jesus into revealing his true power or declaring himself king.

Satanic Influence: The Gospels of Luke and John suggest that satan entered Judas, implying a supernatural influence behind his betrayal.

Part of God's Plan: Some Christian interpretations view Judas's betrayal as a necessary evil, predestined by God to bring about Jesus's death and the salvation of humanity. However, this raises complex questions about free will and divine sovereignty.
